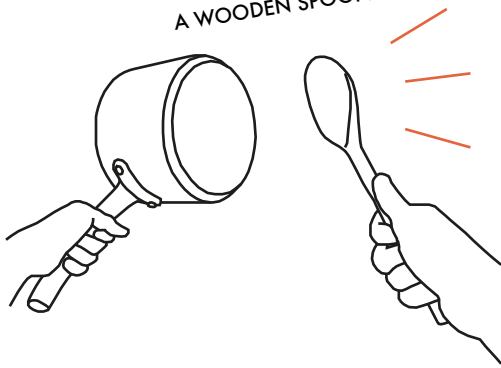

Try some of the ideas below for inspiration if you get stuck

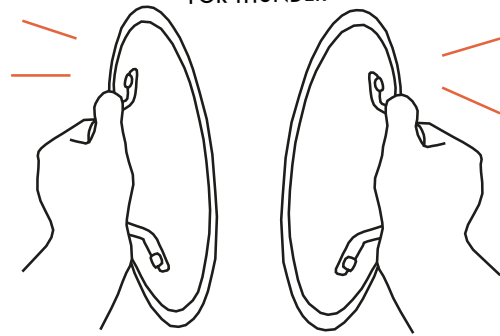
### BASH!

FOR THUNDER



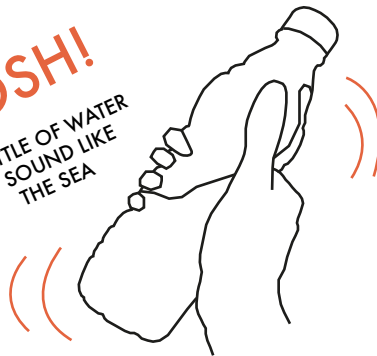
### RATTLE!
